Cocktail Reception with Stanford Law School Dean Larry Kramer 6:30-8:00 p.m. on Monday, 27 August 2007

We are delighted to invite Stanford alumni to a small and informal cocktail reception with the Dean of the Stanford Law School on 27 August 2007.

Considered one of the leading legal scholars in the country, Dean Larry Kramer has contributed path-breaking work on state-state and state-federal conflict of laws, federalism and its history, and most recently, the role of courts in society. Prior to joining the Stanford faculty in 2004, Dean Kramer was the Associate Dean for Research and Academics and Russell D. Niles Professor of Law at New York University School of Law. He was also professor of law at the University of Chicago and the University of Michigan law schools. His current research addresses the issue of judicial review and the role of courts in a constitutional democracy. His book, *The People Themselves: Popular Constitutionalism and Judicial Review*, revives and alters the debate about the relationship of the U.S. Supreme Court to politics.

Dean Kramer received his AB from Brown University and a JD from the University of Chicago Law School. He clerked for the late Judge Henry J. Friendly of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, and the late Justice William J. Brennan, Jr., of the U.S. Supreme Court.
